

THE EVRAZIA INTERNATIONAL AWARDS

The Evrazia International Awards (hereinafter referred to as the “Awards”) are the first-ever international award aimed at recognizing and supporting outstanding individuals and organizations that contribute to the social and cross-cultural development of countries on the Eurasian continent, and that have had a significant impact on preserving traditional spiritual and moral values and overcoming information barriers between the countries of the Eurasian region.

The Awards were held for the first time **in 2025**.

More than 3,700 applications were submitted from 80 regions of Russia and 27 countries.

Following the preliminary round, **more than 800 nominees were selected.**

Based on the results of expert and open international voting, **45 winners were selected**, and their names were announced at a formal prizegiving ceremony on October 29, 2025, in Moscow. More than 300,000 people from 50 countries took part in the open public vote on the Awards platform.

2026 EVRAZIA INTERNATIONAL AWARDS:

1. TIMELINE FOR THE MAIN STAGES OF THE AWARDS:

- **April 7 – August 30 (21 weeks)** – Applications for the Awards may be submitted.
- **September 7 – September 27** – Expert evaluation of applications
- **October 5 – October 13** – Open international voting
- In-person project presentations to the jury members and a formal prizegiving ceremony for Awards winners will be held over a 3-day period between **October 13 and November 15**.

2. The PROGRAM in Moscow for participants will include:

- In-person project presentations and project evaluations by jury members;
- Business program: roundtable discussions with experts in various fields;
- Sightseeing program;
- A formal prizegiving ceremony for the winners.

3. PRIZE FUND: 17 million rubles (1.7 million for each category): 1st place — 1 million rubles

2nd place — 500,000 rubles

3rd place — 200,000 rubles

4. AWARDS:

- Commemorative figurines and certificates confirming the title of winner;
- Commemorative gifts bearing the Awards branding;
- Winners become experts and ambassadors for the Awards;
- Priority integration of the winners into other projects of ANO Evrazia;
- Media coverage for the winners.

5. AWARDS CATEGORIES

1. Global Language

For a significant contribution to the promotion of the Russian language as a means of intercultural communication in the countries of the Eurasian region. For individuals and legal entities.

2. Cultural Code

For the implementation of projects in the fields of culture and the arts aimed at preserving traditional values and fostering intercultural exchange. For individuals and legal entities.

3. Bridges of Friendship

For promoting international cooperation in the social and cross-cultural spheres across Eurasia. For individuals and legal entities.

4. Eurasia Leader

For a personal contribution to the creation of projects that have had a significant impact on the development of public life in Eurasia. For individuals.

5. Memory of Generations

For projects aimed at preserving historical memory and the truth, and combating the falsification of history. For individuals and legal entities.

6. Voice of Eurasia

For providing objective coverage of Eurasian integration, cultural heritage, and social initiatives, as well as countering the distortion of facts regarding world events. For individuals and legal entities.

7. Bright Start

For original ideas and projects aimed at fostering international cooperation and promoting traditional values. For teenagers aged 14–17.

8. Art of Teaching

For contributions to the development of a system of upbringing and education for the younger generation in accordance with traditional values. For individuals and legal entities.

9. Call of the Heart

For active volunteer work and the development of projects in the field of healthcare. For individuals and legal entities.

10. Special Award from the General Partner (Rossotrudnichestvo)

The shortlisted nominees will present their projects to the jury members in Moscow. The jury consists of members of the expert council, ambassadors, prominent figures, and media personalities.
